Latina Project Advocates provide the following:

- Safety planning with victims and their family to explore options while increasing safety
- Information about victim rights as well as options and support in criminal, civil, and immigration courts
- Victim support through escorts to hospitals, social services, attorneys, court, and other agencies
- Information about legal remedies and options for immigrant victims of crime- including assisting with gathering necessary documents for filing for a Visa
- Assisting victims explore their needs and options by providing information about agencies and their services
- Spanish speaking weekly Support Group and Therapy services
